MT-1 and MT-2 Forms and Process: LOMA/LOMR Training

FEMA-Region 8 and the North Dakota State Water Commission are sponsoring a FREE National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) workshop in Grand Forks on Tuesday, October 23rd and in Minot on Thursday, October 25th.
