DWR To Provide NFIP Updates At North Dakota Township Officers Association Annual Convention

BISMARCK, N.D. – Representatives from the North Dakota Department of Water Resources (DWR) will be attending the North Dakota Township Officers Association Annual Convention at the Ramada Inn in Bismarck on December 8–9.

DWR’s Tyler Spomer, along with Nic Cullen from Houston Engineering, will be available at the DWR booth to discuss Senate Bill 2027 and what it means for communities participating in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).

A key component of SB 2027 is the shift of floodplain management responsibilities from townships to counties. Tyler and Nic will be on hand to help township officials understand what this change means for their jurisdiction, what responsibilities remain, and how counties can prepare to assume these duties.

Township officials are encouraged to stop by the booth to ask questions and learn how these updates may affect local administration of the NFIP.
